

# THE BIG QUESTION...

## WHAT'S SO SPECIAL ABOUT THE BIBLE?

The Bible is the world's **best selling** book, with an estimated **4 billion** copies sold in the last 50 years. Why is it so popular? Let's look at two reasons.

While we struggle to predict tomorrow's weather, the Bible accurately predicts events hundreds of years in the future. This is a unique book!

#### IT'S RELIARIE



The Bible is a unique collection of 66 individual books, penned by more than 40 different writers, in 3 different languages, over

a period of around **1,500** years. Many of the writers lived at different times and in different countries, yet amazingly the 66 books fit together perfectly without contradiction.

The reason for this is that while there were over 40 writers, there was really only one author behind it all, God Himself.

We can have confidence that the Bible is the true **Word of God** because many of its **prophecies** have already been fulfilled. Here are a few examples:

- Jesus would be born in Bethlehem (Micah 5 700BC).
- He would be brought up in Nazareth (Isaiah 11 700BC).
- He would be betrayed (Psalm 41 1000BC), for 30 pieces of silver (Zechariah 11 520BC).
- He would be crucified (Zechariah 12 520BC) before rising from the dead (Psalm 16 1000BC).

#### IT'S RELEVANT

The Bible is not a dry, dusty old book as some would suggest. Rather, it is God's unchanging message to mankind. It's the **Creator's handbook** for life on earth, containing instructions for living and directions to Heaven. It tells us where we came from, why we're here and where we're going next!

The Bible explains to us the **problem** of sin which separates us from God and prohibits us from entering Heaven. It's main purpose though is to tell us of the **remedy**. How God sent His only Son, **Jesus Christ**, to be the Saviour of the world. It explains how through **faith** in Him we can receive **forgiveness** and enter into a relationship with God which leads ultimately to a home in **Heaven**.

The Bible may not look too exciting on the outside, but what's inside is truly **life-changing!** Pick it up, have a read, and see for yourself!

## AUDREY'S NEW LEASE OF LIFE...

Audrey Ferguson
has lived in
Methven for over 15
years now, and is
probably one of the few



people in the village who can say that their life has been the subject of a **book!** 

Growing up in **Perth** with her parents (who also now live in Methven) and her 4 sisters, Audrey remembers having a fun childhood. She said; "Being the youngest of five girls, home life was seldom quiet - there were frequent fights over the hair-dryer!"

It was as a young girl that Audrey made a decision that would impact the rest of her life. She explains; "I grew up surrounded by committed Christians, but I was not one myself. At the age of eight I made a personal decision to put my trust in Jesus Christ and accept Him as my Saviour. Without Him I wouldn't have been able to cope with the challenges life has brought since."

For many years after that Audrey was extremely active in helping to run Perth Gospel Hall Sunday School, and in organising Tayside Christian Youth Camps, amongst other things, alongside her childhood sweetheart Adrian, whom she married in 1994.

However in **1997** Audrey was diagnosed with an extremely rare lung condition; **LAM** or lymphangioleiomyomatosis, which significantly impacted her health.

Audrey said, "I tried not to let it affect me too much, but I obviously had to adapt my lifestyle." After several years of having to carry an oxygen cylinder everywhere, she eventually received a life-saving lung transplant, in August 2008, after eight false alarms.

Following surgery Audrey lay in intensive care for almost a month. Reflecting on the experience she said, "The operation itself went well but there were a lot of complications. The new lung just didn't work and for the first 24 hours it looked as if I wouldn't pull through. But amazingly the lung did start to work after a second investigatory operation. The surgeon had all but given up hope. As a Christian I believe it was a miracle, a real answer to prayer."



Now **nine years** on, Audrey is actively engaged in many of the things she enjoyed before. Looking back she said, "I see this as a gift from

God. My faith has been the bedrock of my life. I still cannot understand how or why people live without God."

Audrey's husband, Adrian, recounts their journey in a book called 'Kept, Safely Kept' which was published in 2011. The Methven Messenger has some copies to give away this month (see

### A SAGRIFIGE WORTH REMEMBERING

In 1920 a memorial was erected in Methven, bearing the names of 52 local men who lost their lives in WW1.

Just a few miles away in the tiny village of Harrietfield is another memorial displaying the names of 19 men who died in WW1 and a further 5 who died in WW2.



These men, along with many hundreds of thousands of others, courageously laid down their lives on the battlefield for the sake of King and Country. As the inscription on the memorial in Harrietfield says; 'They gave their lives that others might live. They gave their today for our tomorrow.' Their sacrifice secured our freedom and future. For this we are, of course, all extremely grateful.

Each year on the 11th November we rightly salute their sacrifice. Often the words of



Robert Laurence Binyon's poem, 'For the Fallen', are quoted.

They shall grow not old, as we that are left grow old:

Age shall not weary them, nor the vears condemn.

At the going down of the sun and in the morning
We will remember them.

The Bible says that the sacrifice of one's life for the sake of others is the ultimate demonstration of love. Jesus said "Greater love has no one than this, that someone lay down his life for his friends." (John 15:13).

However, Jesus Himself would go on to display an even more **incredible love** than that, when He voluntarily laid down His life upon the **cross**. On the cross He took the **punishment** which each one of us deserved as a consequence of breaking **God's laws**.

Through His **suffering** and **sacrifice** the Lord Jesus Christ has provided **forgiveness** and **freedom** from sin



and a **future** in Heaven for all those who will put their **trust** in Him.

Sadly **very few** people today remember the **greatest sacrifice** that ever was made when *"Christ died for our sins"* (1 Corinthians 15:3).

Have you ever considered how much Jesus must **love** you to have been willing to **die** for you?

The Apostle Paul once wrote concerning Christ's sacrifice: "The Son of God…loved me and gave Himself for me" (Galatians 2:20).

It was very **personal** to him. What does it all mean to **you** today?



#### **INSTRUCTIONS:**
